It is a pleasure to invite you to this season of concerts and music services celebrating my retirement as Cantor of the Lutheran Church of Honolulu after 38 years. Over the years we have presented many musical masterworks and Hawaii premieres. This season will be no exception.

The two major events will be the first-ever performances of the landmark *Vespers of 1610* by Claudio Monteverdi, marking the 400th anniversary of this monumental publication. These concerts will be presented in two different cathedral venues especially well suited to the sonic splendor of this music. The concert season will conclude with Johann Sebastian Bach's great *Mass in B minor*. It is indeed fitting that the compilation of this great masterpiece done at the end of the composer's career, will also mark the culmination of my ministry at the Lutheran Church of Honolulu. The *Mass in B minor* has not been performed in Honolulu since May 2000.

In addition to the concerts highlighted in this brochure, there will be many special music services throughout the season, which are listed below. I sincerely hope you will join us for this celebration.

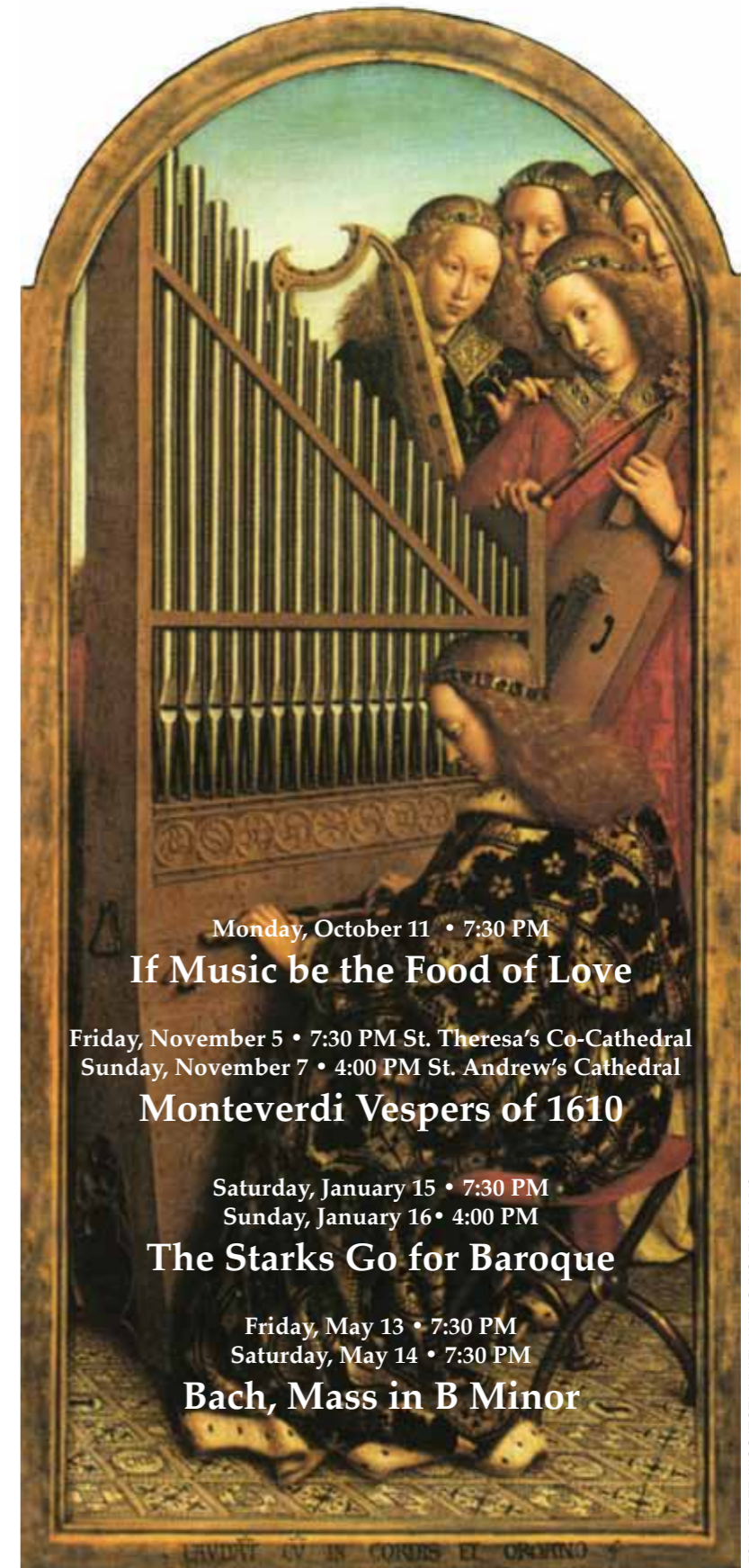
