The service is based on the Great "O" Antiphons, which refer to the seven names of the Messiah: O Wisdom, O Adonai, O Root of Jess, O Key of David, O Rising Dawn, O King of Nations, and O Emmanuel. These seven antiphons for the basis for the verses of the beloved Advent hymn, "O come, o come Emmanuel," which choirmaster Carl Crosier has set for congregation, choir, and handbells.

Church members have fabricated banners for each symbol, which will be presented in procession during each corresponding lesson and musical selection. Carols and anthems by Peter R. Hallock, William Mathias, Anton Bruckner, Peter maxwell Davies, Andreas Hammerschmidt, Herbert Howells, and Bob Chilcott will be performed by the Lutheran Church of Honolulu Choir and Compline Choir, conducted by Carl Crosier, Allen Bauchle, and Keane Ishii, with Katherine Crosier at the organ.
