The LCH Choir sings at the 10:00 am service on alternating Sundays, all special seasonal liturgies, vespers, and at least one concert per year. The ensemble prepares over 200 works each year, ranging from ancient chant, Renaissance polyphony, Baroque works to masters of the 19th, 20th, and 21st centuries, most in their original



languages of Latin, German, French, Hebrew, and even Scandinavian languages and high church Slavonic. The choir has performed many choral works of J. S. Bach, having presented over 50 cantatas, all six motets, both versions of the Magnificat and the complete Christmas Oratorio.
