Dear LCH friends, members, and LCH alumni,

Maika'i ke Akua! God is good! The Lutheran Church of Honolulu celebrates 125 years of ministry in 2025: 125 years of music, fellowship, and love of God and neighbor! We hope many of you, especially LCH alumni, will join the celebrations from September 7 to 14.

We pray that if LCH years of ministry have touched you personally, you will join us in pushing our 125th Anniversary Fundraiser over the top!

Our goal is \$125,000. To date, we have raised \$85,000. Can you help us get to \$ 125,000 by September 1?

We are delighted to report that we have received \$65,000 in gifts and pledges for enhancements to the Rudolph von Beckerath organ. Work commences this month. Plus, we have raised over \$20,000 towards our \$60,000 mission goal. *Mahalo nui loa* for your generosity!

Funds raised for our mission goal will further the *Welcoming and Safe Environment* and *Silver Tsunami* (*Caring for our Kupuna*) priorities identified in our '*Ohana* group meetings. We intend to set aside \$50,000 of the mission funds for much-needed improvements to our campus. Meanwhile, \$4,000 will be set aside as seed money for programming for our *kupuna*. As is our practice, we will set aside a tenth of what we raise to the synod.
